I am delighted to let you know the following project in your constituency has been successful in applying to the Coastal Revival Fund.

Lytham Hall and Historic Parkland (Phase II)

Submitted by Heritage Trust for the North West, the aim of this project is to restore the exterior of Grade 1 listed Lytham Hall helping to establish a sustainable heritage attraction of regional significance. We are providing a grant of £42,500 towards this project, which will support the potential of Lytham Hall and its parkland, in playing a major part in the life and economy of Lytham and the Fylde coast.

It is exciting to see money from the Coastal Revival Fund help bring our wonderful coastal historic assets back into economic use. This is so important in demonstrating our support to coastal communities in their efforts to bring sustainable economic regeneration to their towns

We are announcing 23 Coastal Revival Fund applications in England who will each receive a grant. Collectively, this brings our support in this round of the Fund to 48 projects worth almost £2 million. I look forward to following the progress of each and every project and to see the impact it will have in our coastal areas.
